Our main aims at Barton St Peters are to:

Engaging all children in activity; raising the awareness of healthy lifestyles and the impact on lives; raising confidence and enjoyment of activity to promote active healthy lives; ensuring staff confidence and abilities are up to date; children to recognise the importance of active and healthy lifestyles, increasing physical well-being, ensuring children have the opportunity to compete in competitive activity.
